



CLUBMARK BRONZE GUIDE

So you are interested in the Hockey Ireland Clubmark programme but are wondering how to get started or involved. This guide will help you through the steps required for your club to achieve ClubMark Bronze.

- 1** – Check with your Club Development Committee and following agreement to apply for the programme, appoint a Clubmark Co-ordinator/Committee to get the programme started
- 2** – Contact your Hockey Ireland Provincial Development Officer for any further support and/or discuss the programme
- 3** – Download the PDF version of the Clubmark Bronze online Application form from the Clubmark page on Hockey Ireland Website [Here](#)
- 4** – Using the resource links on the PDF version of the Clubmark Bronze online application form and on the Clubmark Bronze Toolkit page ensure that you have all requirements for the online application form (**note the Clubmark Bronze application form is only accepted through the online form, printed versions will not be accepted**)
- 5** – Complete the Clubmark Bronze online application form (**please note this form cannot be saved and returned to, it must be completed in one session**) with your clubs details using the PDF version as a template
- 6** – If you answer no to any of the requirements please get in touch with your Provincial Development Officer for support on getting this requirement up and running in your club
- 7** – Your Provincial Development Officer will receive your clubs Clubmark Bronze online application form and will be in touch if they require any further information with regards to any of the requirements.
- 8** – Your Provincial Development Officer will confirm if your club has been successful with their ClubMark Bronze application. If your club is successful Hockey Ireland will arrange for a framed certificate to be sent to the club and the club will be given access to the Clubmark Bronze logo for use on your website.
- 10** – Clubmark Silver will be launched late 2021
