

Garda Vetting e-Vetting steps

- 1. Applicant completes a Hockey Ireland e-Vetting ID Validation form (below).
- 2. Applicant presents their original identification documentation to their Club Children's Officer/Club Secretary/Club President for validation (score must total at least 100 e.g. passport & utility bill one form of ID must confirm applicants current address in addition to a form of photographic identification).
- 3. Applicants can email their e-Vetting ID validation form to <u>vetting@hockey.ie</u>

Applicants must complete an online application form therefore a VALID EMAIL ADDRESS IS A <u>MUST</u>.

- 4. Applicant will receive an e-mail from <u>evetting.donotreply@garda.ie</u> with a link inviting him/her to complete the online e-Vetting Application Form. This link will expire after 30 days and you will be required to re-apply. If you do not receive an email within <u>10 days</u> of submitting your ID validation form to Hockey Ireland, please contact<u>vetting@hockey.ie</u>
- 5. Applicant completes the e-Vetting Application Form online and submits it to Hockey Ireland. <u>Please note:</u> Detailed addresses from birth must be entered separately and postal codes are required for all Northern Ireland addresses. If you do not know the postal code please enter 'unknown'. If NI postal codes are not inserted, applications will be returned.
- 6. The Hockey Ireland Liaison Person reviews the Vetting Application Form and submits it to the National Vetting Bureau for processing.
- 7. The National Vetting Bureau processes the application and forwards a vetting disclosure certificate to the Hockey Ireland Liaison Person.
- 8. Hockey Ireland reviews the vetting disclosure and provides a response to the applicant via email.
- 9. The applicant should then pass this correspondence to the Children's Officer (or appropriate person) in their Hockey Club for their records.
