

## Young Hockey Leaders - Mentor Role Description

## What is a Young Hockey Leaders Mentor?

A mentor is responsible for the ongoing development and deployment of Young Leaders within a club.

## What are the key responsibilities of the mentor?

- 1. Be the main contact with Hockey Ireland with regards to Young Leaders
- 2. Attend the Young Leaders course Organise coaching and umpiring practice sessions for the children
- 3. Ensure the Young Leaders are encouraged to complete the programme
- 4. Direct the Young Leaders on a pathway e.g. organise coaching courses for those interested in becoming a coach
- 5. Get the most out of the Young Leaders for your club
- 6. Identify and rectify any problems experienced by the Young Leaders e.g. abuse from parents in umpiring

Hockey Ireland will provide you with a mentoring resource that you can use. You can also contact us at any time to ask questions. It is advisable that your club Young Leader Mentor has a minimum of a Level 1 coaching award, and a basic umpiring course.
