Joanne Quinn (Ards & Ulster) made her debut for Ireland on 25th September 1982 against the USA in an International Quadrangular Tournament at Durham University. During her illustrious hockey career she proved to be an outstanding attacking player with excellent pace and skill and an ability to score goals from any angle. She was a member of the team that won the 1983 Intercontinental Cup in Kuala Lumpur – probably Ireland's most monumental victory in International hockey. In 1984 she played in the 1st European Cup in Lille as well as the 2nd European Cup in 1987 in London. In 1986 she also played in the 6th Women's Hockey World Cup in Amsterdam.
