INTERNATIONAL CAREER: 1980 - 1991

INTERNATIONAL CAPS: 108

POSITION: DEFENDER

At U21 Level John McKee won a silver medal at the 1978 European U21 Championships in Dublin and finished 8th at the first U21 Junior World Cup in Versailles. John (Belfast YMCA/Holywood 87/Banbridge) made his international debut in June 1980 in a 4-Nations Tournament in Aberdeen and went on to win 108 Irish caps and 40 Indoor caps in a distinguished hockey career. A talented, versatile player, he was equally skilful in both defence and attack. In 1981 he was in the squad for the 2nd Intercontinental Cup in Kuala Lumpur where Ireland reached the semi-finals. He played in two Intercontinental Cups – Barcelona 1985 and New Jersey 1989 and two European Championships – Moscow 1987 and Paris 1991. He also featured in the 1990 World Cup in Lahore and the Olympic Qualifying Tournament in New Zealand in 1991
