POSITION: DEFENDER

John Clarke played his first International match against Scotland in 1972. He went on to gain 56 Caps playing notably in the 1978 World Cup in Argentina, the 3rd European Cup in Hanover 1978 and the Intercontinental Cup 1977 in Rome where Ireland finished in the silver medal position. He was also a member of the 1973 tour to Southern African countries.

John was a neat and astute player, a brave and dogged defender to the point of two dislocated shoulders and a broken nose all in the interests of defence. He was a most accomplished defender with a strong tackle that made him a player much respected by the opposition.
