Legends of Trish Hockey In his long and illustrious career for Banbridge, Ulster and Ireland Mark Sinnamon excelled as a defender. He was a strong energetic player with amazing stamina and was renowned for his penalty corner expertise. He was first capped for Ireland in 1975 against Denmark in Vienna and went on to play for Ireland on 61 occasions including the World Cup in Buenos Aires in 1978. One of the highlights of his illustrious career was the Intercontinental Cup in Rome in 1978 where he was rated as one of the outstanding Irish players and was nominated Sports Star of the Week by the Irish Independent.
