The only Kerry woman to have played hockey for Ireland, Mary Geaney started her hockey career with Old Ursulines Hockey Club in Cork. Her outstanding performances for Munster were soon noticed and she began her long International career in 1971 when she was selected to play against England in Cambridge. Her remarkable agility and uncanny anticipation between the posts earned her many plaudits. Highlights of her career were winning the Triple Crown in 1977 and the Intercontinental Cup in Kuala Lumpur in 1983.
