1. OVERVIEW OF ROLE

Connacht Branch is a non-profit, governing body for hockey in Connacht, which is an affiliate member of the National Governing Body, Hockey Ireland.

We are currently looking to recruit an assistant coach and goalie coach to assist the U18 Head Coach in delivering our U18 interprovincial programme. Training sessions will primarily take place at the University of Galway hockey facility in Dangan, Galway.

The U18 programme aims to develop players to participate in the Hockey Ireland Interprovincial Tournament with a view to developing pathways for elite players to progress to the national Hockey Ireland Pathway Performance Programmes.

- Support the delivery of the U18 programme designed by the Head Coach and provide assistance in preparing any reports to the interprovincial manager.

- Regularly provide feedback to players within programme.
- Liaise regularly with other interprovincial coaches.
- Always articulate the Core Values of the Connacht Hockey Branch, both on and off the pitch.

- Openness and willingness to share with Connacht academy and other interprovincial coaches & managers.
- Ability to motivate and inspire.
- Excellent communications (verbal and written).
- Proven methodologies in the development of talent and performance.
- Exceptional people skills, with an emphasis on the management of player.

- Previous experience of working in a competitive hockey coaching environment.
- A competent knowledge of the latest coaching software systems.
